The FP7 SCOT Project (Smart CO₂ Transformation) is organizing a conference on Carbon Dioxide Utilisation in Essen, Germany that will take place on the 28th of September.

The SCOT team will present its **Vision on Carbon Dioxide Utilisation** and the **Strategic European Research Agenda for Europe**. The floor is then opened to the views of high level speakers from politics and industry. We expect plenty of discussions, and welcome you to take part in it. SCOT wants to hear the voices of all participants. Break-out sessions in smaller groups promise **intense knowledge exchange and discussions** on the various aspects of CDU.
